Section 491.3(g)(3) of Title 18 NYCRR is amended to read follows:

- (3) Upon written request by the operator, the department m waive the capacity limits set forth in paragraph (1) of this subdivision. An exception [shall] $\underline{\text{will}}$ be granted only upon demonstration by the operation:
- (i) there are compelling conditions which necessitate to establishment of a larger facility; and
- (ii) the physical plant and proposed program comply wi department regulations and applicable local codes.

Any such waiver granted to a social services district will I limited to an original term of six months duration and may be extended f additional six month periods. Such waiver cannot be granted unless to department has received from the social services district in which to shelter for adults is located, and has approved, a plan for the reduction the population housed in the shelter for adults. Any extension of a waive may be granted only upon submission to the department of a supplemental platfor the reduction of the population housed in the shelter for adults and to department's approval of the plan. The social services district cannot admit or retain a number of persons in excess of the capacity specified the department after review of the district's waiver requests.
