


# Step 3: Program Details and Step 4: Select Component A or B

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## Step 3: Estimated Total Base Score

- Step 3: Program Details* will provide you with the estimated total base score for the application. The score is automatically calculated using the point categories and REDC where the applicant's facility will be located.

Estimated base RFA scores can go as high as 100 points. The higher the score, the more likely an applicant is to qualify for funding. The base score does NOT include additional RFA bonus points that are available for infant/toddler care (+5 points) or non-traditional hours (+5 points). Therefore, it is possible for a total score to be as high as 110 points.

## Step 3: Funding and License Selections

- Programs receiving 100% of their funding from public sources are not eligible for this grant. **Select No** for the public funding question if you do not receive 100% of your funding from public sources.

### Step 3: Eligibility and Requirements and Signature

1. **Read the Eligibility and requirements statements.**
2. **Check the box next to, “I understand and agree to the statements above and the guidelines for use of funds.”**
3. **Type your Full Legal Name** into the provided field.
4. **Click the Save and Next** button.

Outcomes and Program Requirements.

The following providers are NOT eligible to apply under this RFA:

- Programs that became newly licensed /registered/permited on or after 1/28/2022
- Programs that do not meet requirements for expansion
- NYC Article 47 day care centers are not eligible under this RFA if they are proposing to change age groups they are serving or add an additional age group that they are not currently licensed for (separate permits are needed to serve under three and over three). Those that are 22 proposing to serve a different age group from their current program and need a new license are eligible under RFA#1.
- Programs that receive 100% of their funding from public sources such as Head Start/Early Head Start or publicly-funded Pre-K programs are not eligible.

### Step 4: Select Component A or Component B

1. *Step 4: Select Component A or Component B* will be pre-selected for you based upon your facility type and cannot be modified.
2. **Click on Save and Next** to continue to Step 5.

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- Component A Eligible Programs DCC SACC Programs to expand child care in existing Day Care Centers, including Day Care Centers permitted by NYC DOHMH, and in School Age Child Care programs. The goal of Component A is to expand program licensure for up to 25 slots in existing child care programs Awards will be final after any license changes are approved. If a program cannot expand their existing license to add additional slots, they will be consider not eligible for an award.
- Component B: Small Day Care Centers (SDCC), Family Day Care (FDC)/ Group Family Day Care (GFDC) For Component B (1) or more of the following: 1) expanding program hours to include non-traditional hours care, 2) enrolling at least 1 special needs child by six months after the date of their preapproval letter, or 3) enrolling at least 1 infant/toddler child by six months after the date of their preapproval letter. Important Note: If you are a Component B program (SDCC/FDC/GFDC) that is already designated as providing nontraditional hour care, you can only apply under #2 and or #3 above (serving infant/toddlers or children with special needs) assuming you are under enrolled and without displacing existing children.
