Dear Chief Executive Officer,

Thank you for submitting Sullivan County's Supervision and Treatment Services for Juveniles Program (STSJP) plan for Program Year (PY) 2020-2021. Your entire STSJP plan, including any amounts listed for PY 2020-2021 STSJP-RTA, has been **approved.**

The County is eligible to receive 62% State reimbursement for STSJP expenditures up to the capped STSJP allocation amount. Your municipality will continue to receive 49% State reimbursement for eligible detention services expenditures up to the capped allocation amount. If your municipality shifts a portion of its detention allocation into its STSJP plan, your municipality will receive 62% State reimbursement, up to the capped allocation, if such shifted funds are spent on STSJP eligible expenditures. A municipality may make a detention allocation shift at the time of the STSJP plan submission or up until June 30, 2021, unless otherwise approved by the Office of Children and Family Services.

If the County plans to shift its detention allocation for STSJP eligible expenses, please submit a request on official letterhead to Lynn Tubbs and email it to stsjp@ocfs.ny.gov outlining

1. the amount that will be shifted and
2. the type of programming or services the re-purposed detention funds will be used for under STSJP

Once the shift is approved, an amended STSJP plan will need to be submitted.

As a reminder, to access RTA reimbursement that a municipality may be eligible for, the expenditures must be specifically included in a locality's comprehensive RTA plan.

All STSJP claims, inclusive of STSJP-RTA, must be submitted electronically via the Juvenile Detention Automated System (JDAS) for the service period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021. These programs are designated to serve the entire County but there will be an increased need in the more populated areas of the Town of Thompson, Town of Fallsburg, Town of Liberty and that represents approximately 50% of Sullivan County's population which according to 2017 data is 74,545. The median household income in the

County is \$52,027 and the population wide poverty rate is 16.9%. Poverty rate increases annually and cost of living increases and the job market nor wages haven't grown. Poverty has been one of the leading factors in Sullivan County. There have been 6 detention admissions and 1 placement in 2019.

The general population racial/ethnic distributions for Sullivan County in 2017 was 60% white and 40 % black. The Department of Family Services, Probation Department and Youth Advocate Programs will work together to identify any barriers to services and to make recommendations for appropriate services that account for these barriers. As per the numbers in our reports, the admissions are majority hispanic youth.

This plan was developed primarily within the Sullivan County Department of Family Services and the Sullivan County Probation Department. Youth Advocate Programs was also consulted for their portion of the plan. Recently, Sullivan County has made the decision to take advantage of this opportunity and as the plan progresses and its progress is evaluated, more departments and service providers may be incorporated into the collaborative development in the future. Progress with this plan will also be evaluated on an ongoing basis through the Designated Assessment Service (DAS) Committee which includes members from the Department of Family Services, Probation Department, Department of Community Services, Dispute Resolution Center, Access Supports for Living, Rehabilitation Support Services, Berkshire Farm and Center for youth and Youth Advocate Programs.

Will allow for Probation Officers to have more time to observe youth during high risk times and have more face to face contacts with school and parents by assisting with staffing and overtime costs. The extra supervision that will be made available will also improve the ability to work directly with the youth to identify and reduce behaviors that could increase their chances of requiring placement. This program will include drug testing if applicable to monitor youth's compliance, this is for adjudicated youth. Upon receiving a youth case, the probation department completes a Youth Assessment, that essential measures risk, and needs factors. Subsequently, a comprehensive individualized case plan is formed to establish specific goals and objectives tailored to appropriately fit each youth. Based on these case plans, when deemed necessary, service referrals will be put in place. These services include, but are not limited to; Mental Health treatment, substance abuse treatment, vocational training/career readiness programs, and community service. If necessary, referrals can also be made to provide families of the youth with support from Case Workers. Every 3 months, a reassessment is completed to monitor/track the youths progress, or regression. If the youth displays regression, graduated responses are then put in place, which may include; more frequent reporting, curfew, or court notification.
